The maximum class size is 25 students.

You will:

- » work in pairs or small groups to improve your spoken fluency, accuracy and pronunciation
- » get scores and feedback from your teacher on your homework

What will I achieve?

- » take this course again, if you need more preparation
- » apply to study another subject at college

How will I be assessed?

You will sit practice exams that will be scored. You will also get feedback from your teacher on practice exam results and homework.

Entry requirements

You must be able to study in the college for at least two hours per week. To join this course, you must speak with a member of the teaching team first. They will check that this is the right course for you.

- » When you first come to the college, please bring along your passport, EU ID card or Visa (if you entered the UK from outside the ELI)
- » If you entered the UK to join a spouse or relative, you will also need to bring your spouse's/relative's passport.
